Q. Will my logo rub off?

A. Yes, all logos will fade with time. No cleaner will guarantee that it won't. Logos are inked on not stamped on.

Q. Will the "Cymbal Polisher" clean up to a 20"

A. The Cymbal Polisher will accept a 10" cymbal to 22" no problem.

Q. Will cleaning my cymbals change the tone? **A.** Yes, cleaning your cymbals will make them crisp, clean & clear sounding. Plus look good under stage lights.

Q. Will the "Cymbal Polisher" take off the protective coating on my cymbals? **A.** Yes, the coating will come off eventually. Depending on what cleaner you may use.

Q. What cleaner do you recommend? **A.** Use whatever cleaner you are comfortable with. Or manufacture recommendation, when you purchase your cymbals.

Q. Will the cymbal come off while it's spin-

A. No. the motor is turning counter clockwise thus tightening the wing nut as it turns, making it completely safe.

Q. What voltage does the "Cymbal Polisher" use?

A. Standard 110 v. 3 pronged plug.

Q. Will the "Cymbal Polisher" scratch my cymbals?

A. No it won't, use common sense and don't use hard abrasive chemicals with grid; sand paper, etc.

Q. Will cleaning my cymbals regularly, deteriorate and make them weak? A. No! Cleaning your cymbals will keep the tarnish and oxidation from setting in, that comes from acid sweat, finger prints, and humidity. In turn will eat the alloys that make your cymbals what they are.

If you take care of your cymbals they will last for years to come. They will take care of you, saving you thousands of dollars!!

Please read all instructions & warnings before attempting to use this product.

The Cymbal Polisher® eliminates endless hours of scrubbing, polishing, and straining fingers, wrist, arms, and elbows. Easy application no more black stains on clothes while cleaning.

For years of heavy tarnish and green spots, it's recommended you use spot treatment. Spot treat cymbals with a soft toothbrush with cymbal or brass polish, or presoak your cymbal with your favorite polish.

For tarnished cymbals follow these 10 easy steps:

- 1. Place the "Cymbal Polisher®" on the ground preferably on the carpet and NOT a slick surface. (For some unbalanced cymbals wobbling may occur.) Place both feet on the platform at the bottom of the Cymbal Polisher® next to the handles.
- Turn speed control to the "ON" position, the motor will turn fast. Slow the motor down by turning speed control knob clockwise until motor stops completely.
- 3. Remove wing nut washer and top felt pad ONLY.

- 4. Place your cymbal onto the Cymbal Polisher® between the two felt pads. Replace washer and wing nut, and tighten to a snug fit.
- 5. Turn speed control knob counter clockwise slowly, the cymbal will begin to rotate. Adjust speed from Slow to Fast as needed.
- 6. Turning the speed control half-way on this will provide enough torque.
- 7. We recommend using "Latex Gloves" and apply your favorite polish onto a cloth.
- 8. Start with the bell of the cymbal. Place cloth with polish close to the Start with the bell of the cymbal. Place cloth with polish close to the wing nut, and work your way out to the edge in sections. Slowly applying MINIMAL PRESSURE to the cymbal. (Putting too much pressure WILL NOT clean cymbals any faster! DO NOT bog the motor down with too much pressure, this will burn the motor up. Your cloth will turn black with tarnish, turn the cloth will turn the cloth. CAUTION: If the cloth snags on wing nut let go immediately and turn



9. To stop, turn speed control clockwise to slow. Using your cleaning cloth, grab the edge of the cymbal and use it as a break until the cymbal comes to a complete stop.

10. Turn the cymbal over and repeat the process on the bottom side of the cymbal.

Keep legs away from rotating cymbals. CAUTIONS: Keep Out of Reach of Children. Do NOT use the Cymbal Polisher™ on cracked cymbals.
